

2012-2013 Annual Report

NPC libraries were able to work on several components of the College Strategic Plan for 2012-14.

<u>Implement Information Literacy Competency Standards for Higher Education</u> (NPC Strategic Plan 1.1.2)

- 1. Research Strategies were added to the Library webpage so that students can learn individually how to find and use information.
- 2. Faculty has reduced their requests for library instructional/orientation sessions. The reason for this decrease in unknown.

3. The Library conducted a student survey March 2013 using the college's new online survey site. Only 56 students (out of 4,143) responded. The results seem to indicate that some students are unaware of Library resources and services. This is an insignificant number of responses but shows trends.

- 4. The Social & Behavioral Sciences departments will ask the Library for analysis of Works Cited Pages of research papers submitted for Fall 2013 classes.
- 5. The English department has not decided if they want to assess information literacy using this approach mentioned in #4.
- 6. The copyright webpages maintained by the Library were removed. The links for all copyright information now directs persons to Columbia University where the College Attorney has referred faculty.

Create adequate support services to enhance student success (NPC Strategic Plan 1.1.4)

- 1. Various parts of the collection were reviewed and weeded/discarded if material was no longer relevant, or out-of-date. Reference Collection, Government Documents Collection, call number sections of K, L, R, and T plus removal of general pictorial works, guidebooks, description and travel books. In the Serials Collection, microfiche of old issues were removed and storage period for print journals was reviewed.
- 2. We will continue to participate in the Federal Depository Library Program. A decision was made to keep the microfiche; however, the equipment at Little Colorado Campus, Silver Creek Campus and White Mountain Campus has failed. Sales staff for microfiche reader/printers are not responding to our requests for product information. We may have to review our decision to keep the government microfiche. Another issue is the unknown factor of which department will pay for the equipment. There is one microfiche reader/printer with film adapter at Painted Desert Campus which is operational. The New York Times on microfilm was moved to the Painted Desert Campus Library.
- 3. Text-A- Librarian service was implemented in June 2013. [see chart on page 1 #3]
- 4. The Electronic Book Collection from EBSCO <u>increased</u> from 383 last year to 439 as of June 30, 2013. Usage <u>decreased</u> from 252 in 2011-12 to 205 in 2012-13. The reason for this is unknown. \$6114.92 was spent on the electronic book collection. Access is provided from a separate web page for Electronic Books as well as individual title links within the library catalog. [Refer also to chart on page 1 #3.]
- 5. The <u>decrease</u> in use of resources and services is not known. There could be many factors such as less emphasis on research and writing, lack of awareness and training for Library resources, more faculty acceptance of general Internet web sites, lower enrollment, lack of sign-in for computers, etc.

The increase in catalog searches with decreased borrowing could be related to lack of skills using a Library catalog or the Library not owning materials being searched. The Public Catalog Search Statistic monthly reports show lack of skills and a drop in Reference questions indicate people are less likely to ask questions. [see chart on page 2 #5.]

7. The Library reviewed and corrected 1,400 MARC records in the Library Catalog with broken URLs.

<u>Increase technology availability, access, and support that focuses on students needs</u> (NPC Strategic Plan 3.1.1)

- 1. The Library student survey asked questions about technology needs. As a result Text-a-Librarian service was implemented. [see chart on page 1 #3]
- 2. Marketing dropped the Library web pages from the NPC Google Analytics account. The Library has not had time to explore other options for counting use of web pages.
- 3. The Library migrated to a new Library Catalog interface.
- 4. The Library requests for the ability to monitor tests on a computer were still on hold.
- 5. The Library requests for computer reservation and print management were still on hold.
- 6. Computers from the Disabilities Resource Access office were moved back to the Libraries since Libraries are open longer than any other office/department/room. Not all components were transferred. This is not resolved.
- 7. The Library had difficulty maintaining EZProxy server due to changes in the Information Services Department. This is not fully resolved.
- 8. Offered to help Support Center understand Library services and resources to assist students.
- 9. Requested camera and monitor replacements for testing areas. This is not completed.
- 10. The Little Colorado Campus Library security gate is still not functioning properly.
- 11. The Library provided students an explanatory sheet to forward College e-mail to their preferred personal e-mail account.
- 12. Information Services provided privacy screens for computers at the Library front desks to protect student records.

13. Disc cleaning equipment was purchased for each campus Library to clean and repair DVDs and CD-Roms.

Establish a grants management function (NPC Strategic Plan 5.2.1)

1. The Library maintains a small print Grants Collection and provides access to GrantSelect database.

Implement facilities resources to improve student success (NPC Strategic Plan 6.1.2)

1. Requested a meeting with the Director of Facilities. Not yet scheduled.

Improve availability and use of current facilities (NPC Strategic Plan 6.2.1)

- 1. Fliers were posted in classrooms advertising Group Study rooms via reservations at Campus and Center offices. Library group study rooms were previously converted to either a testing area or the Archives at the Painted Desert Campus Library.
- 2. Campus Managers at Little Colorado Campus, Silver Creek Campus, and White Mountain Campus agreed to direct students thru hallway doors to avoid unnecessary traffic in Libraries and reduce distractions and noise levels. The Painted Desert Campus Library has a different layout with minimal use of a classroom accessed via the Library.
- 3. Library layouts were changed at Hopi Center, Little Colorado Campus, Silver Creek Campus, White Mountain Campus to provide better access to electrical outlets, Internet ports, quiet areas, and create a welcoming environment.
- 4. Whiteriver closed their Library during finals to provide quiet study and testing area. This was appreciated by the students since the Library is usually busy/noisy with the public using computers within the Library.
- 5. St. Johns Center remodeled to allow for expansion of a multi-learning (model) classroom which also changed the Library and test areas.
- 6. Springerville/Eagar Center moved to a new location. One result was less use of Library computers.
