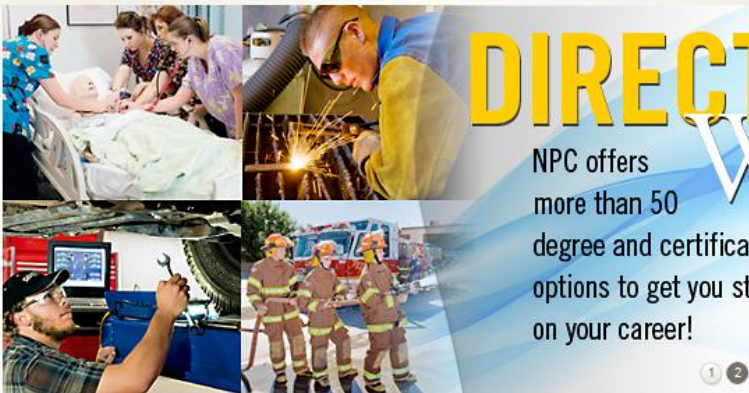

General/Multiple Topics:

- ▶ **Directory of Open Access Journals** Full-text, quality controlled scientific and scholarly journals. There are 665 journals searchable at the article level.
- ▶ **FDsys** from U.S. Government Printing Office. Public access to documents submitted by Congress and federal agencies. Replacing GPO Access.
- ▶ **Google Scholar** simple way to broadly search for scholarly literature. From one place, you can search across many disciplines and sources: articles, theses, books, abstracts and court opinions, from academic publishers, professional societies, online repositories, universities and other web sites.
- ▶ **JURN** an academic search-engine, indexing 4,413 free e-journals in arts and humanities
- ▶ **USA.gov** official web portal for the U.S. government and agencies
- ▶ **World Bank Open Data**; The World Bank is a global organization whose goal is to fight poverty. There are over 2,000 statistical indicators available here.

Health and Medicine:

- ▶ **Health and Environmental Research Online** from U.S. Environmental Protection Agency. HERO contains the key studies EPA uses to develop environmental risk assessments for the public.
- ▶ **Health Care** from U.S. government agencies
- ▶ **Medline Plus** from National Library of Medicine. Information about diseases, treatment, drugs, vitamins. Includes encyclopedia and dictionary.
- ▶ **National Guideline Clearinghouse** is a comprehensive database of evidence-based clinical practice

Clicking on a category will take you to databases in that category OR Scroll through the list.

If your topic relates to “states rights debates leading to the American Civil War”, do not search in a health database.

Notice the variety of information.

The descriptions can help determine which database to search.

Be sure to get name of database, date viewed, article title & author, etc. for your citations. **Check the style manual to see what is required.**

National Guideline Clearinghouse is a comprehensive database of evidence-based clinical practice guidelines and related documents. Collaboration of The Agency for Healthcare Research Quality, U.S. Department of Health & Human Services, and the American Medical Association.

▶ **Nutrient Data Laboratory**. U.S. Department of Agriculture. Nutrient content of the U.S. national food supply for more than 100 nutrients for over 7,000 foods.

▶ **PubMed** from National Library of Medicine. Digital archive of biomedical and life sciences journal literature. Use the limits tab for free full-text and English language only.











