- 1) Subcommittee Reports
  - a) #1: Will be presenting report on subgroup's activities to the District Governing Board meeting on Dec. 18.
  - b) #2: Will meet today following SPASC main to analyze results their survey results
  - c) #3: Group continues approaching tasks by posting questions for which data will be needed
  - d) #4: Donna reported on behalf of Leslie Collins. Leslie is meeting on individual basis with group members to develop list of data needs.
    - (1) List will go to the data committee (see later for procedure)
  - e) #5: Eric Bishop reported for Curtis Casey. Group would like permission to add Business & Industry Coordinator David Hansen to membership. (Committee OK'd). Continues working on matching goals with pillars, and will have a meeting in late January on the audio system.

- f) Communications Team will meet with Jeanne on December 13.
- g) The group's focus will be on how to publicize the HLC resource site/center that Trudy is constructing and compiling.
- h) Will also consider promoting activities center on mock up of Self-Study that should be done by the end of spring 2008.
- i) An abbreviated delegation of the Assessment Academy group (Eric Bishop & Pat Canary) will attend a January session of the Academy. All members of the group will travel to Lisle for February session.
  - (1) Jeanne says they are free to use the proposal she drafted for entry into the Academy or start fresh with one of their own devising.
- j) The Compliance vs. Commitment HLC team will continue their schedule of meeting with groups to initiate a culture of caring about assessment.
  - (1) Have done presentation to President/VP executive council
  - (2) Will do short presentation at next DGB and then plan to appear at next Deans meeting

- k) Jeanne reported on her recent Peer Review Core Training session, points that will be useful when we draft our self-study
  - (a) Examples of evidence have high priority
  - (b) Self study report should be done in a "single voice"
  - (c) Reduce redundancy
    - 1. Focus on conciseness and clarity
  - (d) Investigating teams can comment on our assessment activities, but can invoke no actions as long as we are participants in the Assessment Academy
    - 1. Therefore, school must follow through on its Academy commitment
- 2) Data requests procedures were worked out
  - (a) Requests from the various committees and sub groups will be "triaged" and come first to SPASC main, where they will be vetted and then sent on to the Data team.
    - 1. The data team will provide data to the requestors who then will report their satisfaction to SPASC main.
- 3) College Council will be addressing the "Great Ideas Assignment" at its meeting this afternoon.
- 4) HLC will send two facilitators to present the Constellation Survey results at the January 11 Conversation Day Convocation.
  - a) Vital Focus team will meet before then and decide on roles it needs to undertake
  - b) Rose will type audience responses
  - c) Jeanne's office will be sending out the day's agenda to everyone
  - d) Because the emphasis will be on HLC visit, there won't be time to do usual convocation activities such as meeting the new hires and making longevity awards
    - (1) May have additional NPC event later in the year (a picnic?) where these activities could take place
    - (2) This will be announced at end of Conversation Day
