

## NEW MEXICO RESIDENT TUITION WAIVER PROGRAM

Northland Pioneer College and Western New Mexico University, Silver City, New Mexico, have established an out-of-state tuition waiver agreement. New Mexico residents who attend Northland Pioneer College may be assessed Arizona Resident Tuition. Likewise, Arizona residents attending Western New Mexico University may qualify for New Mexico Resident Tuition. There are a limited number of waivers for each location. Out-of-state tuition may be waived for students taking 1 or more credits.

In order to apply for the New Mexico Student Tuition Waiver at Northland Pioneer College, an application for a New Mexico Resident Tuition Waiver must be sent by the applicant to:

The following regulations apply:

- 1. Legal residency in New Mexico.
- 2. Acceptance to Northland Pioneer College.
- 3. Must register for 1 or more credits at Northland Pioneer College.
- 4. Maintenance of a minimum 2.0 cumulative grade point average or above.

As the number of New Mexico Resident Tuition Waivers available is limited, the following guidelines will be used to determine awarding of waivers (listed in order of priority).

- 1. Returning Northland Pioneer College students currently receiving tuition waivers.
- 2. All other admitted students based upon the date the application is received by Northland Pioneer College.
- 3. Students at the time of registration if any New Mexico Resident Tuition Waivers are still available.
