

## NPC Friends and Family is pleased to offer the Jon Graff, Ph.D., CTE Scholarship

\$500 toward tuition, books and fees for the SPRING 2019 semester

One scholarship to an NPC student pursuing an Associate Degree, Certificate of Applied Science or Certificate of Proficiency in Career and Technical Education will be awarded.

This scholarship is designed for academically and/or technically talented students who have unmet financial need.

## Who is eligible to apply?

Returning NPC Students are welcome to apply.

## Criteria:

- Degree-seeking at NPC. Degree plan on file indicates the applicant's goal is an associate degree or certificate of proficiency in CTE
- Demonstrate financial need. This is a NEED based scholarship.
- Successfully completed prior college-level (100-level or higher) credits at NPC.
- Enrolled for 6 or more credits at NPC during the semester of award
- Cumulative G.P.A of 3.0 or better at the time of award
- High school diploma or GED at the time of application
- In good academic standing, not in default of a student loan and not in overpayment status.
- Students who have a Bachelor's degree or currently in high school at the time of award are not eligible to apply.

Applicants must have the recommendation of at least one representative from NPC faculty or high school faculty, and one representative from NPC Student Services, as evidenced by two letters of support that accompany the application.

You must have completed and submitted a 2018-2019 FAFSA to NPC Financial Aid Office to apply for this scholarship, demonstrating that you have financial need, or obtain a denial letter from NPC Financial Aid, indicating why you are ineligible for financial aid.

## How do I apply?

Submit 1) completed NPC Friends & Family Scholarship Cover Letter form, 2) attached <u>essay of 500 words or fewer</u> describing your educational and career goals, and how this scholarship will help you achieve them, 3) unofficial transcript, 4) <u>proof of financial aid status</u> (financial aid award or denial letter), and 5) two letters of recommendation <u>as described above</u>, on or before Thursday, November 15<sup>th</sup>, 2018 <u>at noon MST</u>, to:
