Post-graduation Employment

Similar to the external certification outcomes data, individual departments also keep track of their graduates' employment status. All departments used a variety of methods to define and collect post-graduation employment information (e.g., student phone interviews and surveys, Facebook research, and student contacts with instructors). Completeness of data is subject to time and resource constraints, as well as the ability to obtain up-to-date student contact information, especially those who had already graduated from NPC.
