Graduation & Transfers

The table below displays two sets of externally reported graduation and transfer data. Primarily due to differences in cohort definitions and external reporting specifications, these rates reflect performance from different student subpopulations. In general, the cohorts defined under Strategic Vision reporting contain a slightly larger student group than those in the IPEDS reports. Nonetheless, across all reporting years, the fall cohorts defined by either IPEDS or Strategic Vision external reporting requirements were not representative of all the students enrolled at NPC. The IPEDS and Strategic Vision rates shown in the table accounted for less than 10% of the entire NPC credit-bearing student populations.
