

## NPC FRIENDS AND FAMILY FILL-THE-GAPS SCHOLARSHIP

\$500 toward tuition, books and fees for the FALL 2020 semester

One scholarship to a student at each campus, and one scholarship to a student at each center each semester.

This is a need-based scholarship, for students who are receiving the PELL grant but can demonstrate financial need.

## Criteria:

Degree-seeking at NPC.

Demonstrate financial need. This is a NEED-based scholarship.

Successfully completed prior credits at NPC at the time of award.

Enrolled for 6 or more credits at NPC during the semester of award.

Cumulative Grade-Point Average of 2.0 or better.

High school diploma or GED®.

Not in default of a student loan and not in overpayment status.

Students who have previously obtained a Bachelor's degree should contact Betsyann Wilson. Students currently in high school at the time of award are not eligible to apply.

If you have not done so, file your FAFSA ASAP! You must provide a financial aid award letter for Fall 2020 to receive this scholarship.

## **How Do You Apply?**

Submit all application documents electronically to <u>betsy.wilson@npc.edu</u>. Paper applications will not be accepted; your campus office or advisor can assist you in scanning the documents as required: Attach all application documents as a single .pdf file in the order given below. You may take your application to a campus or center and request that the front office or library scan them as a single .pdf file as follows:

- Essay 500 words or fewer Addressing the following:
- What are your career goals;
- What are your educational goals;
- What resources you have to fund your education making you qualified to receive this scholarship; and
- Why the scholarship is needed, and specifically how it will be used.
- Demonstration of financial status as evidenced by award letter from NPC Financial Aid Office
- NPC Degree audit (Contact an NPC Academic Adviser) <u>or</u> your unofficial transcript from <u>https://mynpc.npc.edu/ics</u> indicating your degree intent.

Scholarship recipients may re-apply for the award in subsequent academic years (not to exceed <u>four consecutive</u> semesters).

Application Deadline: Thursday, April 16 at 12:00 p.m. MST., for funding for the Fall 2020 semester. Applications received after this date/time will not be accepted, regardless of why they are late. You are STRONGLY advised to submit your application well in advance of the deadline date! If you submit your application prior to Monday, March 30, and it is incomplete or requires revisions, Betsyann Wilson will make every effort to assist you in making corrections. Applications received after Monday, March 30 will be accepted "as is."
