

NPC FRIENDS AND FAMILY LEG-UP SCHOLARSHIP

\$500 toward tuition, books and fees for the FALL 2020 semester

One scholarship to a student at each campus, and one scholarship to a student at each center each semester.

This is a need-based scholarship, for students who are ineligible for the PELL, but who can demonstrate financial need.

Criteria:

Degree-seeking at NPC.

Demonstrate financial need. This is a NEED-based scholarship.

Successfully completed prior credits at NPC at the time of award.

Enrolled for 6 or more credits at NPC during the semester of award.

Cumulative Grade-Point Average of 2.0 or better.

High school diploma or GED®.

Not in default of a student loan and not in overpayment status.

Students who have previously obtained a Bachelor's degree should contact Betsyann Wilson. Students currently in high school at the time of award are not eligible to apply.

You must have written proof from the NPC Financial Aid Office that you are NOT eligible to receive the Pell grant. Please request and obtain this proof (financial aid denial letter) before applying for this scholarship.

If you are unable to complete the FAFSA, due to circumstances beyond your control, please contact Betsyann Wilson at 928-536-6245 prior to submitting your application.

How Do You Apply? You may choose one of the following:

- Submit all application documents via inter-campus courier by taking them to your nearest campus or center and requesting that they be sent to Betsyann Wilson at Silver Creek Campus.

Application documents:

- Essay 500 words or fewer Addressing the following:
- What are your career goals;
- What are your educational goals;
- What resources you have to fund your education making you qualified to receive this scholarship; and
- Why the scholarship is needed, and specifically how it will be used.
- Demonstration of financial status as evidenced by letter from NPC Financial Aid Office
- NPC Degree audit (Contact an NPC Academic Adviser) <u>or</u> your unofficial transcript from <u>https://mynpc.npc.edu/ics</u> indicating your degree intent.

Scholarship recipients may re-apply for the award in subsequent academic years (not to exceed <u>four consecutive</u> semesters).

Application Deadline: Monday, May 18 at 12:00 p.m. MST., for funding for the Fall 2020 semester. Applications received after this date/time will not be accepted, regardless of why they are late.
