Obtaining a bachelor's degree in education equips individuals with the essential knowledge and skills required to become effective and impactful teachers. These degree programs provide a deep understanding of educational theories, child development, and classroom management techniques, preparing graduates to create engaging and supportive learning environments.

NPC graduates of the AAS in Early Childhood Studies or AAEC degree are automatically accepted into the BAS, ECE. NPC graduates of the AAEE are automatically accepted into the BAEE. Students must have maintained continuous enrollment. For admission, continuously enrolled graduates must meet with the Educator Preparation Program

advising team to update their degree intent within one semester of graduation. Students who have an earned degree in another major, or who have not maintained continuous enrollment must apply for admission into the bachelor's degree program of interest.

The Bachelor of Applied Science (BAS), Early Childhood Education (ECE) degree

provides candidates with specialized, professional preparation to teach young children, PreK through third grade, in a variety of program and school-based settings. The BAS, ECE builds on both the AAEC and the AAS in Early Childhood Studies to deepen teaching knowledge and prepares individuals as highly qualified early childhood educators.

The BAS in ECE includes two student teaching options:

- Birth to PreK option: for those wanting to specialize in the birth to five age group and does not lead to teacher certification
- **K-3rd grade option**: for those seeking early childhood teacher certification

The Bachelor of Arts in Elementary Education (BAEE) degree provides candidates with specialized, professional preparation leading to a career in a private, charter, or district elementary school setting. The BAEE provides a program that sets the groundwork to enter the education profession as a responsive and student-focused teacher.

Students who complete all program requirements for the BAS. ECE or the BAEE will be eligible to receive "Institutional Recommendation" (IR) from the college. Graduates then take their IR, along with other required documentation, to ADE to apply for an elementary education teaching certificate. Using an IR to apply for teacher certification streamlines the process by eliminating the need for ADE to conduct a course by course transcript review. The IR provides the graduate with the benefits of faster processing and reduced fees for the teacher certification application.

With the skills and insights gained within these programs, you will be equipped to create vibrant, inclusive classrooms where every child feels valued and empowered. By becoming an educator, you join a legacy of change-makers dedicated to leaving a lasting, positive imprint on society.

BUSINESS BACHELOR OF APPLIED MANAGEMENT
