Those interested should submit their application on the website listed above. They also recommend you email Jody or Jase to inform them that you applied.

The ILEAD program is the Native Youth Initiative for Leadership, Empowerment, and Development program. It is for Native American Youth between ages 18-24 to learn about nonprofits, grant writing, and community organizing. Interns will also collaborate and coordinate community service projects with other agencies. The last opportunity for the ILEAD internship is Summer 2021 and partial Fall 2021.

The DVFS is their Developing Future Victim Specialist program. This is a great opportunity for those interested in pursuing a career in human services, criminal justice, social work, etc. You will learn Internships for DVFS is every semester, and the next available opportunities are Summer 2021 and Fall 2021. Nearly all of the internship is remote.
