You may need a DPS Level I Fingerprint Clearance Card to register. Plan ahead and start the process NOW—it can take up to 6 weeks!

- 1. Start here and create an individual personal account: <a href="https://psp.azdps.gov/account/login">https://psp.azdps.gov/account/login</a>
- 2. Check your e-mail (don't forget the SPAM folder) for a confirmation link. Click the link, and enter the one time password that was e-mailed to you.
- 3. Follow the prompts Fingerprint Clearance Card > Apply for Card.
- 4. Answer each question. The Reason for Applying is Additional Sponsors, Health Sciences Student and Clinical Assistant ARS 15-1881. (Non-IVP)
- 5. Fill out the application completely, click continue and sign electronically.
- 6. Pay the fee (\$65), then check your e-mail for an *ID number* and information on obtaining *electronic fingerprints*.
- 7. Make an appointment for fingerprints and *take your ID number with you*. The ID number connects your online application with your electronic fingerprints. Please note that a paper application and fingerprint card slows the process a lot and *is not recommended*.
- 8. You card will be mailed to you. Keep it in a safe place and bring it to the first day of class.
