What should a student do once he or she completes their 2021-2022 FAFSA Application?

- Student should allow 3-5 business days for NPC Financial Aid Office to receive their 2021-2022 FAFSA.
- Then follow-up with NPC Financial Aid office to ensure their FAFSA application has been received.

Once the student verifies that the Financial Aid Office has received their 2021-2022 FAFSA the next steps are listed below:
