Students interested in pursuing a degree that leads to teacher certification in PreK – 3rd grade may want to complete their AAEC. This Education Plan maps the suggested and required courses in blocks. *Blocks are suggested for full-time students, but may be adjusted based on course scheduling, student employment, or individual needs. Courses **Highlighted** lead to the Certificate of Proficiency in Early Childhood Studies, while completing all courses on the plan leads to the AAEC.* To ensure you are on track, it is recommended that you meet with the Educator Preparation Programs Advisor prior to registering.
