- Wanting to establish a partnership with NPC.
- Working on a revised IGA that would provide funding to create a 3year position to serve an academy class sergeant.
- 4. NAFCA Chief Chevalier...

Had questions and concerns on:

- Where is the future of the FRS program heading?
- Does not like utilizing out dated equipment.
- Is there funding for replacements on equipment?
- Replacement of Fire Engines.
- Would like to have an "off-the-street" academy, but the barrier is the cost to backfill positions during training.
- 5. Round Table Discussion Open Floor Chad wanted to start off with some discussions.
 - NAPA and NAFCA partners would like to schedule another meeting, in Spring of 2025, to present the strategic plan and action items to the new president.
