NOTE ${ }^{1}$ : ENL 101 automatic placement requires an placement score in the required range in both Reading and Writing placement areas. Scoring in the Student Decision Zone range in Reading or Writing places a student in the "student decision category". Scoring in the TLC Reading or Writing Placement range makes a student ineligible for ENL 101.

NOTE ${ }^{2}$ : MAT 109 has a Reading skill prerequisite. The minimum score is 41 (ASSET) /81(COMPASS). Students with 35-40 (ASSET)/61-80 (COMPASS) may take MAT 109 if they co-enroll in an appropriate TLC Reading course. Students scoring below 35 (ASSET)/61 (COMPASS) must take an appropriate TLC Reading course before taking MAT 109.

NOTE REGARDING SAT SCORES: SAT Composite of 1040 waives Placement for Math, English, and General Education courses. We do not have enough SAT data to include SAT scores in the Placement Chart. Therefore, students scoring below 1040 composite on the SAT must take the ASSET or COMPASS test and use those results for placement.

## 2011-2012 PLACEMENT RULES AND PROCEDURES

## Placement Rules (the short version)

1. NPC students who meet certain conditions must follow the placement rules outlined below. Students who must take the placement test and follow the results are:
a) Students enrolling in courses with placement prerequisites who have not previously taken a placement test or;
b) Students pursuing a NPC Associates Degree, Certificate of Applied Science, or AGEC (Arizona General Education Curriculum).
2. Students may be exempt from the placement system if they meet one or more of the following criteria:
a) Students providing proof of an accredited associates degree or higher, unless the degree includes no college level math;
b) Students providing ASSET or COMPASS scores from another institution;
c) Students providing official transcripts listing a grade of "C" or higher for College Composition I (reading/writing requirement) and/or college level math (math requirement);
d) Students providing ACT or SAT scores which meet NPC placement minimum standards (see placement chart);
e) Students taking courses for Audit grade only. The Audit grade exemption applies only to courses with a placement prerequisite. Courses with course prerequisites may not be waived by this exemption.

## IMPORTANT PLACEMENT NOTES

- Students may test a maximum of three full tests per academic year. This means no more than 3 full tests or 3 tries at any one portion of the test. Advising staff are responsible for monitoring test takes. This makes it important for you to keep test copies on file in student folders and to check the system for recorded scores.
- Placement test scores are effective for a maximum of two years. If more than two years has elapsed since a student tested, and the student now needs to use those test results to enroll in a class, the student must retest.
- Students pay an annual (Fall to Fall) \$10 Placement Testing Fee if they need to test in a given year. The campus/center office will collect the fee. Please follow upcoming Business Office procedure to determine if student has paid fee. This fee went into effect on August 1, 2009.


## Placement Procedures

When a student announces the intention to take a class that may have a course or placement prerequisite, please use the tables in this manual to identify the correct prerequisite. Courses in this manual are listed alphabetically by department. Simply look up the course in question and see if a placement or course prerequisite is listed.

## If there is a placement prerequisite, then:

1. Determine if the student meets any of the exemptions listed in Section 2, Placement Rules;
2. If not, then refer the student to an academic advisor for placement testing;
3. The advisor will administer the placement test, notify the student of the results, and assist the student in registering for appropriate courses.

If you have any questions regarding a student's placement status, please refer the student to an academic advisor.

## If there is a course prerequisite, then:

1. Determine if the student has met the course prerequisite, or;
2. Refer the student to an academic advisor, so the advisor may make that determination.

If you have any questions regarding a student's course prerequisite status, please refer the student to an academic advisor.

If the course prerequisite lists "instructor permission" as an option, please note that the instructor must communicate permission for enrollment to an advisor either in person, via the telephone, or through written and signed communication. Advisors will not accept a student's statement that the student has spoken with the instructor and received permission. Advisors will list the instructor permission in the appropriate area of the registration form (box next to student signature line) or course change form (comments section at bottom of form).

## Prerequisite overrides

Only the Dean of the department in question may override a prerequisite. Prerequisites may not be overridden by instructors, department chairs, or deans from other divisions.

## COMPASS Math Diagnostics, TLC Math, \& MAT 109 Placement Instructions

## DIAGNOSTICS

Students who score in the Diagnostics range of COMPASS will receive a series of 4 Diagnostics scores: Fractions, Decimals, Percents, and Integers. The chart below will assist you in placing students by using the COMPASS scores from these 4 areas.

It is possible for a student to test into a number of TLC courses at once, since the Diagnostic areas recommend placement for different courses. If this occurs, place the student in the lowest course for which they qualify. Diagnostic Areas and courses are listed below from lowest to highest level.

| Diagnostic Area(s) | Score Range | Placement |
| :--- | :--- | :--- |
| Fractions | $0-40$ | TLC 066 |
| Decimals | $0-40$ | TLC 067 |
| Percents | $0-40$ | TLC 067 |
| Fractions, Decimals, and Percents | $41-65$ (all 3 areas*) | TLC 075 or 076 |
| Integers | $0-65$ | TLC 069 |
| Fractions, Decimals, Percents, and | $66-00$ (all 4 areas*) | TLC 092 or MAT100 |
| Integers |  |  |

*Note: If one or more of these Diagnostic scores is below the listed range, place the student in the course matching their lowest placement score.

Example \#1: If a student had a 71 in Fractions, a 71 in Decimals, and a 40 in Percents, the student would not be eligible for TLC 075 or 076. The Percents score is below the listed range for 075 or 076 . The student should be placed in TLC 067, since the student's Percent score places them in that course.

Example \#2: If a student had a 77 in Fractions, a 77 in Percents, a 77 in Integers, but a 65 in Decimals, the student would not be eligible for TLC 092 or MAT 100. The Decimals score is below the listed range for 092 or 100. The student should be placed in TLC 075 or 076, since their scores in all 4 areas are acceptable for either of these courses.

## REMINDER

Students may place up one test placement level from what the scoring says they should take. This applies at all levels of coursework, from TLC 050 to MAT 211. This "one placement up" statement is built in to all the COMPASS scoring results statements. It applies to the TLC Diagnostics scoring above as follows: Students may ignore these scoring results and enroll in MAT 100, 101, 103, 105, or 109. For more details, consult the 2009-2010 Placement Handbook chart.

## TLC MATH

Any student scoring 34 or below on the PreAlgebra test needs to meet with a TLC instructor. TLC would like to give these students the TLC Whole Numbers test - we cannot do that through COMPASS. If a student does fine on Whole Numbers, we can place them using their COMPASS recommendations. If they do poorly on Whole Numbers, TLC will start them in that class. "One Placement Level Up" rule applies here as well.

MAT 109
MAT109 has a Reading score prerequisite as well as a Math score prerequisite. Please use the chart below to place students into MAT 109. Students who score 55 or higher on COMPASS PreAlgebra or 25 or higher on COMPASS Algebra are eligible for MAT 109, if they meet the Reading score minimum. If a student has the Algebra or PreAlgebra minimum for MAT 109, please consult this Reading score chart:

60 or lower reading

81 or higher

Students must complete one TLC
course before they can take MAT 109
Students may enroll in MAT 109 if they co-enroll in appropriate
TLC Reading course (see Reading Placement on printout)
Students may enroll in MAT 109

## DEPARTMENTAL REQUIREMENTS FOR MINIMUM SKILL LEVEL ENTRY

The faculty members of each department have established minimum skill levels for entry into each course offered in the department. Many courses do not have any minimum skill level requirements. This booklet is the most current source of placement recommendations and course prerequisites; it will be used to determine eligibility for course enrollment.

An "X" in the column of the skill required indicates the minimum test score necessary to enter each course. If the student exceeds the minimum score listed or if no minimums are listed the student may enroll in the course if the listed prerequisite courses have been successfully completed. Required ASSET scores are listed first in each column, followed by equivalent COMPASS scores, followed by equivalent ACT scores.

If the student scores below the minimum listed in the skill level, in some courses the student may enroll in the course if he/she co-enrolls in a relevant TLC course. If the course is open for co-enrollment, it will have a "Yes" in the Co-enroll column.

A minimum of one relevant skill building TLC course will be required each semester for coenrollment in courses designated by the "Yes" until the student has; (1) re-tested on the ASSET or COMPASS and scored above the minimum skill levels required, or (2) satisfactorily completed the recommended TLC course or course sequence.

All appeals for exceptions to the skill levels presented in this booklet will be referred to the Vice President of Student Services.

NOTE REGARDING GENERAL EDUCATION COURSE PLACEMENT: Most General Education transfer courses have placement score minimums for Writing, Reading, and/or Numerical Skills (PreAlgebra). Those general cut scores are:

- Writing - 35 ASSET/38 COMPASS/14 ACT
- Reading - 36 ASSET/65 COMPASS/14 ACT
- Numeric Skills/PreAlgebra - 34 ASSET/35 COMPASS/14 ACT.

NOTE: Please note that all new or modified courses have been bolded in the tables that follow. Any courses with new or modified prerequisites also have the prerequisite bolded.

NOTE: ASSET minimum score is listed first in each column, followed by equivalent COMPASS score, followed by equivalent ACT score. COMPASS PreAlgebra test is equivalent to ASSET Numerical Skills test and ACT Math test.
