Remodel at Snowflake Student Center

Recommendation:

Staff recommends awarding a contract to Restore Pro to remodel the Snowflake Student Center not to exceed \$155,000.

Procurement Process and Budget Information:

An evaluation by the Procurement Manager has found that the regular competitive purchasing activity would significantly disrupt timelines and the work currently in progress. Restore Pro is already contracted by our insurance company and already performing work on the Student Center. Cost for the remodel would be covered from contingency funding.

Summary:

The remodel would accommodate a more functional floor-plan, the project would address the One-Stop-Shop layout and provide additional office spaces. It would also capture lost floorspace and make it usable for offices and a student commons area. This project would have to start immediately to have the building available for fall classes.

With the student center in a state of refurbishment from the flood, now would be a perfect time to make changes to the layout of the building and save money by costs already being paid by insurance. This upgrade would create a fluid, user friendly space where students could access most of their needs.

- One-Stop-Shop area would be all-inclusive with Advising, Financial Aid, Campus Office and a Testing room near the front door of the building.
- Five (5) additional offices would be created by adding and removing walls and doors.
- A new conference room would be created out of the front vestibule area that serves little purpose.
- Lounge area would offer a refrigerator, microwave, bottle filler and seating for students in the front area of the Student Center.
- Due to a 6-8week wait time for the AZ State fire marshal to review the plans we would need to start now to finish in time for Fall classes.

SUBJECT: Restore Pro Inc. - Competition impracticable

Restore Pro Inc. has been contracted by *The Trust* to perform repairs associated with an insurance claim resulting from water damages. During the course of repairs, an opportunity to perform minor changes to align the facility with NPC's "One Stop Shop" concept was identified and *Restore Pro Inc.* was requested to quote the desired changes.

The quoted cost proposal for the additional work provides a stated not to exceed (NTE) total of \$155,000.00, per procedure 2335, sealed proposals are required for purchases exceeding \$49,999.99. *Restore Pro Inc.* is currently performing closely related work associated with an active insurance claim and other renovations associated with the "One-Stop Shop" campus design philosophy, a competitive purchasing activity would significantly disrupt timelines and the work currently in progress. Due to the potential disruption and negative impact to student experience, competitive procurement is deemed impractical. In order to mitigate potential service disruption and fulfill obligations to our students, *Restore Pro Inc.* is determined to be the firm most capable of meeting the needs of the College.
