#### **NPC Finish Line Tuition Waiver:**

- This <u>tuition only</u> waiver is available to NPC students who have 6 or less credit hours remaining to complete their Bachelor Degree (4-year program). Total credit hours NOT to exceed 6 attempted credit hours
- Students who have earned a Bachelor's Degree (or higher) previously are not eligible to apply.
- Students who used the Associate's finish line are eligible for the Bachelor finish line application if completing a Bachelor program.
- Certificate programs (CAS and CP) are not eligible for this tuition waiver.
- This tuition waiver is intended for students who DO NOT qualify for the Federal Pell Grant
- Media fee, course fees and textbooks are not paid by this tuition waiver and are the responsibility of the student.
