**College & Career Preparation – 2026-2027:** *Blocks are roughly based on six credit enrollments per semester, but may be adjusted based on course scheduling, student employment, or individual needs. These pathways are meant to provide a general outline of CCP classes per each pathway; students’ course schedules may reflect some or all of these classes.*

**Pathways:**

- Literacy & English Language Learners: For those who are non-Native English speakers
- ABE/ASE: For those whose placement scores for reading, writing, and/or math place them at or below an 8th grade level. Students’ progression within this category may deviate from the timeline below depending upon their initial placement and course completion rate.
- HSE/GED-Prep: For those seeking a high school diploma, either through the GED or one of the HSE pathways.
- College Prep: For those with a high school diploma/equivalency needing additional skill development before placing into college-level courses; placement scores are at or above the 9<sup>th</sup> grade level

**\*Note:** Placements and grade level equivalents determined by students’ scores on the Test of Adult Basic Education (TABE). Students are post-tested after completing their CCP course or after their instructor feels they’ve mastered class content; together with instructors’ recommendations, these placement tests determine which class students next need to take depending on their pathway. Classes may also be interchangeable based on students’ needs. ***Students must meet with Learning Assistants and Success Coach to create a personalized plan of their pathway.***
