<u>Associate of Arts Early Childhood (AAEC)</u> - Students interested in pursuing an associate degree that easily transitions to an educator preparation program teaching students in preschool through 3rd grade may choose the Associate of Arts in Early Childhood. The AAEC includes all Arizona General Education for state universities as well as all requirements for the BAS in Early Childhood Education. This plan maps the suggested and required courses in blocks. *Blocks are suggested for full-time students, but may be adjusted based on course scheduling, student employment, or individual needs. Courses Highlighted lead to the Certificate of Proficiency in Early Childhood Studies, while completing all courses on the plan leads to the AAEC degree.* To ensure you are on track, it is recommended that you meet with the Educator Preparation Programs Advisor prior to registering. **Courses in BOLD** are taken together during the block.
