Associate of Arts Elementary Education (AAEE) – 2024-25 Catalog-Students interested in pursuing a degree that leads to a teacher preparation program for elementary education and teacher certification (K-8th grade) may want to complete their AAEE. This plan maps the suggested and required courses that provide a foundation for entry into school-based settings as a paraprofessional (teacher's aide) as well as the foundation for a bachelor's degree in elementary education.
