Current TB to start program, annual TB thereafter. MMR x 2, Hep B series, and Varicella x 2. COVID vaccination may also be required by clinical agencies.

CPR/First Aid is required prior to the Nursing Assistant Program and again during the Nursing Program

CPR for Healthcare Providers and First Aid cost ½ credit tuition (\$47), plus a \$20 course fee. Navajo/Apache County = \$67

The estimated dollar amount for the books / resources for the Nursing Program is \$1402 (1st yr) + \$261 (2nd yr).
