**Criteria:**

- Degree seeking in ITT/EIT at Northland Pioneer College
- Demonstrate financial need. Need is prioritized for this scholarship.
- Enrolled for 6 or more credits at NPC during the semester of award.
- Cumulative Grade-Point Average of 2.5 or better on a 4.0 scale.
- Must be in good academic standing: **not** over the credit limit, in default of a student loan or in overpayment status.

**How Do You Apply?** Submit all application documents electronically to [NPCFF@npc.edu](mailto:NPCFF@npc.edu). **Paper applications will not be accepted; your campus office or advisor can assist you in scanning the documents as required: Attach all application documents as a single .pdf file in the order given below:**

***Application documents:***

1. Completed, signed and dated [NPC Friends and Family Scholarship Cover Letter Form](#)
2. Essay – 500 words or fewer – Describing:
  - What are your career goals;
  - What are your educational goals;
  - Why the scholarship is needed, and how it will be used to help you achieve your goals.

3. Your unofficial transcript from <https://mynpc.npc.edu/ics> indicating your degree intent; students without an NPC transcript must submit a degree plan (see academic advisor)
4. Demonstration of financial status for the **24-25 academic year**, as evidenced by Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), FAFSA Submission Summary (**FSS**) **PAGES 1 & 2 ONLY** or letter of award or denial from NPC Financial Aid Office or MyNPC page.
