 - Explain your commitment to maintaining enrollment and completing your BAM in two years.
 - Describe the value you bring to Northland Pioneer College's BAM program.
 - What resources do you have to fund your education making you qualified to receive this scholarship; and
 - Why the scholarship is needed, and specifically how it will be used.
- **3.** Demonstration of financial status as evidenced by 2025-2026 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) FAFSA Submission Summary (FSS) PAGE 1 ONLY, or letter of award or denial from NPC Financial Aid Office or MyNPC page for the academic year of the scholarship.

- 6. Applicants must have the recommendation of at least two individuals, including at least one college faculty member and one business professional or community member, as evidenced by letters of support.
