- 1. Essay 500 words or fewer Addressing the following:
 - What are your career goals;
 - What are your educational goals;
 - What resources do you have to fund your education, making you qualified to receive this scholarship;
 - Why the scholarship is needed, and specifically how it will be used.

The key to the scholarship essay is that it is a personal narrative, reflecting your experiences and goals. DO NOT USE ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE, SUCH AS CHAT GPT, to write your essay. It is important that your personal voice come through!

- 2. Demonstration of financial status as evidenced by Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) **FAFSA Submission Summary (FSS) PAGE 1 ONLY for the 2025-26 academic year**, or letter of award from NPC Financial Aid Office or MyNPC page.
- **3.** Your unofficial transcript from https://mynpc.npc.edu/ics indicating your degree intent; students without an NPC transcript must submit a degree plan (see academic advisor)
- 4. Letter from high school showing the applicant is on track to graduate in Spring 2025.
- 5. Unofficial HS transcript
- 6. One letter of recommendation from a high school or college instructor or a recommender of the applicant's choice. The recommender should reference the applicant by name in their letter.

Application Deadline: Thursday, April 17 at 12:00 p.m. (noon) MST., for funding for the FALL 2025 semester.
