Call to Order- The NORTHEAST ARIZONA TRAINING CENTER Executive Board Meeting was called to order at 03:03 PM on May 19, 2026 by Chad Kreuger via WebEx and in-person.

1. New Business:

- a. *Insurance Approval* - Chad Kreuger. Chad stated the meeting was called to finalize action on NATC's annual insurance renewals. McNeil and Company (General Liability Insurance) annual premium is \$29,604.00. Cost is consistent with prior year. Hancock & Leavitt (Shooting Range) annual premium is \$3,366.38. Slight increase due to updated application details (tiny homes usage).

Motion made by Brian Gardner to approve payment of both insurance premiums, Jeremy second, motion passed.

Shooting range berm improvement project goes before the Navajo County Board of Supervisors on May 26. Chadley reported positive recruitment trends: New agencies expressing interest; and Agencies returning after prior absences. Gila County agency interviewed NATC as one of four academies and reserved two seats. Currently there are 18 seats reserved for the upcoming academy.

Jeremy reported that NATC's Congressional Directed Spending (CDS) request advanced past the first stage with support from Senator Kelly and Senator Gallego.

Jeremy briefed the board on potential funding from county-collected development fees associated with new wind and solar projects: County has collected approximately \$9 million to date; Funds are distributed to community projects; and NATC may be eligible to request support.

2. Future Agenda Items – Chad Kreuger

- Chad will conduct a periodic comparison of insurance providers to ensure pricing remains competitive.
- Jeremy will consult Rich Channick regarding the best approach for requesting CDS matching funds money from NATC partners. Chad will follow up as well.
