



Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program

CCP classrooms are now intake centers for any members of the public that need to apply for SNAP (Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program, formerly known as food stamps) benefits.

SNAP provides households with EBT cards loaded monthly with funds to purchase food

To apply for benefits, people should bring: proof of any income (pay stubs, tax returns, social security benefits statements, unemployment checks, etc); current ID (driver's license, birth certificate, US passport, immigration/naturalization certificate); proof of US citizenship or legal residency for each person in the household applying for benefits. Students and members of the public can both apply for SNAP benefits at Student Writing Centers.
