## The NPC Friends and Family Doris Reed Nursing Scholarship

This scholarship was established by the family of Doris Reed in honor of her career of fifty-plus years in Nursing. It will provide \$1000 toward tuition, books, fees and related expenses to students enrolled in an NPC Nursing and Allied Health degree program for the SPRING 2024 semester.

## Who is eligible to apply?

NPC Nursing and Allied Health students who meet the following criteria:

- Enrolled in a degree program in Nursing and Allied Health with a degree plan on file
- NOT eligible for financial aid Applicant MUST have proof that they are not eligible for financial aid to apply
- Enrolled in at least six credit hours during the semester of award
- Cumulative G.P.A of 3.0 or better on a 4.0 scale
- Not in overpayment status at NPC; over the credit limit Contact betsy.wilson@npc.edu
- Preference is given to students who can demonstrate and clearly describe their financial need

Awardee must write a letter of thanks to "The Family of Doris Reed", and email it to <a href="mailto:betsy.wilson@npc.edu">betsy.wilson@npc.edu</a>, before funds are disbursed to awardee.

## Attach all application documents as directed on the online application form:

## **Application documents:**

- Essay 500 words or fewer Describing:
  - What are your career goals;
  - o What are your educational goals;
  - o What resources you have to fund your education making you qualified to receive this scholarship; and
  - o Why the scholarship is needed, and how it will be used.

The key to the scholarship essay is that it is a personal narrative, reflecting your experiences and goals. DO NOT USE ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE, SUCH AS CHAT GPT, to write your essay. It is important that your personal voice come through!

- Proof that you are NOT eligible to receive financial aid, evidenced by a letter from the NPC Financial Aid
  Office
- Your unofficial transcript from <a href="https://mynpc.npc.edu/ics">https://mynpc.npc.edu/ics</a> indicating your degree intent.

Scholarship recipients may re-apply for this award in subsequent academic years (not to exceed <u>two consecutive</u> semesters).

Application Deadline: Thursday, November 16 at 12:00 p.m. MST., for funding for the SPRING 2024 semester. Applications received after this date/time will not be accepted, regardless of why they are late. You are STRONGLY advised to submit your application well in advance of the deadline date!
